- Safety. General Safety is always a must from everyday activities to well beyond using and working on equipment. Safety must always come first and be used and always maintained in everything we do. We will explain Lock Out/Tag Out and its importance.
- **2. Major Components.** Location and system involvement of major components in the system.
- **3. Marathon Products and Services.** We provide information on the Marathon product offering and the application of our product line.
- **4. Electrical Symbols.** Learn electrical symbols to help understand circuits, certain ways electrical devices are wired, and how they work are key elements for troubleshooting and understanding electrical schematics.
- **5. Electrical schematic reading.** We teach the electrical schematic symbols for the components that make up the Marathon control panels.
- 6. Hydraulic schematic. Hydraulic Schematics, like Electrical Schematics, are road maps for Hydraulic Systems, showing detailed hydraulic routings and independent mapping. Learning how to read schematics will help you understand hydraulic circuits and where to find certain hydraulic components and connections. Reading Hydraulic Schematics is essential for troubleshooting the hydraulic system.
- 7. Electrical panel boxes. Day two is a full day of actual "hands-on" equipment identification and their operation. We will wire panels and simulate or discuss faults that may arise in the field.
- **8. Preventative maintenance.** We include proper preventative maintenance schedules and discuss the importance of maintaining the equipment.
- 9. ANSI. Information covering ANSI safety guidelines.
- 10. Open discussion. Roundtable question and answer periods.
- **11. Plant Tour.** We give the attendees a tour of the facility and show how the Marathon product is assembled in the factory.
